3. What are some tough decisions that you've had to walk through recently (within the last year or two)?

4. What do you think it looks like to 'walk worthy of the Lord'? Would you agree or disagree with the statement – "Christians in our culture often disagree on what walking worthy of the Lord looks like."? Explain.

5. What are some things that we as modern day believers put our faith in besides Jesus? What do you think 'faith in Jesus' looks like when it's put into practice?

6. The Colossian believers were demonstrating a crazy kind of love for people that was dramatically different from the culture around them. What might this kind of radical gospel-driven love look like in our culture?

7. The church, the body of Christ, is where God's Kingdom is supposed to be unmistakable visible. Do you think this is the case or does the church look more like the world around it? Explain.

8. What do you think it would take for us as a modern-day body of believers to demonstrate the type of faith and love that the Colossians demonstrated?
