## Start

1. In the past year, have you grown in any way? If so, in what ways? How do you know you've experienced growth?
2. What is knowledge? Does knowledge involve more than just knowing information? How does a person grow in knowledge?

Read Colossians 1:9-14 and Discuss

3. The knowledge that Paul speaks about here is more than just knowing information. It's a full knowledge that implies that what is known has been put into experience and battle tested. **If this is the case, then how do you think a person grows in the knowledge of God and His will?**
4. What does spiritual growth look like?
5. How is spiritual growth related to fruit production? What is the fruit that Paul speaks about in this passage?
6. In praying for the Colossian believers, Paul did not ask God to give them relief from their difficult circumstances. Instead he prayed that these people would be given strength, endurance and patience and a spirit of gratitude. **Why do you think that Paul prayed for them to experience these things? How are these things related to the 'fruit' that we talked about in the previous question? Why would a Christ-follower need strength, endurance, patience and a grateful spirit?**
